ROCKIN' C RANCH PARENT INFORMATION

Rockin' C Ranch offers the following camp programs:

ROCKIN' C RANCH | DAY CAMP Rockin' C Ranch Day Camp is for children ages 5-10. Day Camp sessions run from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Lunch will be provided each day. Day Campers may attend a maximum of three (3) non-consecutive sessions.

Transportation from Tyler is offered at no additional charge. The bus runs Monday a.m. - Friday a.m. (the bus does not run Friday afternoon). The bus stop is located in the old movie theater parking lot at E. Fifth St and Loop 323, across the street from The Scroll Christian Bookstore.

Day Camp Bus Schedule:

Pick-up between 7:45-8:15 a.m. | Drop-off at 5:30 p.m.

ROCKIN' C RANCH | LAKEFRONT Rockin' C Ranch Lakefront is an overnight camp for kids ages 7-9. This five-day session runs from Sunday afternoon through Saturday morning and is ideal for first-time campers.

ROCKIN' C RANCH | TRAILHEAD Rockin' C Ranch Trailhead is an overnight camp for kids ages 10-11. Sessions run from Sunday afternoon through Saturday morning.

ROCKIN' C RANCH | HILLSIDE Rockin' C Ranch Hillside is an overnight camp for kids ages 11-14 during regular weeks, and ages 13-16 during Teen Weeks. Hillside sessions run from Sunday afternoon through Saturday morning. Compared to Trailhead, Hillside campers have more opportunities to ride horses, more evening events, and may participate in the Saturday rodeo.

CLOSING CEREMONIES Parents are invited to join us for closing ceremonies at the end of each camp session. Day Camp ceremonies are at 5:00 p.m. Friday evening. Lakefront, Trailhead, and Hillside ceremonies begin with the camp rodeo at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday morning.

REGISTRATION/PAYMENT INFORMATION A non-refundable deposit of \$100 or the first monthly payment is due with the application. The deposit applies toward the total tuition fee. Please pay by credit card, check or money order. Tuition for each session includes all meals, activities and equipment needed for activities, one cabin photo, one T-shirt, and camper insurance. Monthly credit card payment options may be arranged to be paid in full by May 1, 2010. Please call the camp office to arrange monthly payments on your credit card or create an account through our online registration to pay in installments.

CANCELLATION POLICY If cancellation occurs before March 1, 2010, all payments except the non-refundable \$100 deposit may be refunded. If cancellation occurs after March 1, 2010, a refund (excluding deposit) will only be given if the space is filled from our waiting list.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION A camper's registration will be confirmed only upon receipt of a completed camper application with deposit, monthly payment, or payment in full. When the deposit and application have been received, a confirmation letter will be emailed or mailed to you along with any camper forms still needed. RANCH BANK Parents may put spending money in their camper's Ranch Bank account for snacks and other items at the camp store. Ranch Bank payments should be made prior to your camper's stay at camp. We suggest \$45 in the Ranch Bank account for overnight campers, and \$25 for Day Campers. Parents may request a cash refund of Ranch Bank balances immediately following their camper's closing ceremony. Balances not refunded will be added to the scholarship fund.

SCHOLARSHIPS Limited partial scholarships are available upon request. Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and individual circumstances. In order to apply for a scholarship, please complete a Scholarship Application in addition to this Summer Camp Application. A copy of the most recent tax return and a \$25 deposit are required for the request to be considered (the \$100 registration deposit will be waived with the Scholarship Application). Scholarship Applications are available at www.RockinCRanch.org/forms.php or through the camp office.



WHO MAY ENROLL Campers are registered on a first-come, first-served basis. Any boy or girl may apply provided they meet the age and gender requirements for the session they choose. Camp management reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any applicant deemed undesirable or not in the best interest of the camp. Children who may pose a risk to themselves or other campers and staff may be dismissed from their session with no refund of fees.

HOMESICKNESS Homesickness is a common and understandable problem for some campers. Please make sure that your child is capable of an overnight stay at camp before sending him or her to Rockin' C Ranch. Please note that campers are not allowed to call home during their stay at Rockin' C Ranch (with the exception of emergencies).

CHORES During his or her stay at Rockin' C Ranch, your camper will complete a variety of ranch chores or building projects. Such chores and projects include feeding and caring for livestock, building and mending fences, gathering eggs from the hen house, and dining hall clean-up. We believe that these projects encourage self-esteem and promote the value of a strong work ethic. Of course, we also reserve plenty of time for fun and entertainment. If your child has any physical restrictions, please let us know in advance.

CABIN MATE REQUESTS Cabin groups are assigned by age. Day campers and overnight campers may request to be grouped with a friend using the cabin or group mate request. Requests may be considered if both campers are not more than two years apart in age and there are no conflicting requests. Please remember only one request will be honored, and both children must request each other. Careful consideration will be given to each request; however, the final decision rests with the Camp Registrar. Requests should be made to the office no later than two weeks prior to the camp session.

PACKING LIST Please make sure your child brings enough clothing for a one-week stay at camp. Day Campers need only the items marked "DC".
